- Click on "Online Resources"
- Scroll down to "FCPL Premium Databases" and select database from list.
- Enter Borrower ID (library card number) and PIN when prompted

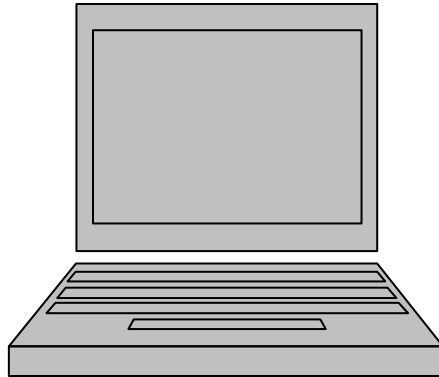
INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING GALILEO

- Go to library website: www.forsythpl.org
- Click on "Online Resources"
- Click on "GALILEO Password & A-Z List"
- Click on "GALILEO Password"
- Enter Borrower ID (library card number) and PIN when prompted
- Note the current GALILEO Password; click "OK"
- Close pop-up window and return to "Online Resources"
- Select database by category or from the "A-Z list"
- Enter GALILEO Password when prompted

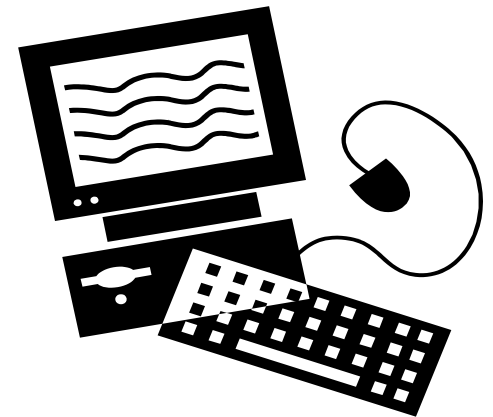

GALILEO

(Georgia Library Learning Online)

The best source for full text articles, GALILEO consists of hundreds of databases indexing thousands of periodicals and scholarly journals on a variety of subjects. Other resources include encyclopedias, business directories and Georgia government publications.

***Ancestry Library Edition**, a comprehensive source for genealogical research, is available through GALILEO, providing the capability of searching census records, the Social Security Death Index, military records and more in one search.

A link to a complete list of databases is available on the GALILEO homepage. A password is necessary for access to many of them.

Forsyth County Public Library cardholders may obtain the current GALILEO Password from Information staff or from the Online Resources page on the library's website.

Auto Repair Reference Center

Auto Repair Reference Center includes repair information, factory drawings and step-by-step photographs, technical service bulletins and recalls, enhanced wiring diagrams, specifications, maintenance schedules, and more for most automotive makes and models. The content is created by ASE certified technicians and updated frequently.

Biography Reference Center

Comprehensive database of biographical information on people of all nationalities and from all periods of history, with some images.

Career Insider

Whether you're just exploring possible careers or are ready for an interview, this database allows you to download industry and employer guidebooks, research top employers, explore industries and professions, read insider reports and career advice articles, get tips on interviewing and writing resumes and cover letters, and more.

LearnATest

LearnATest offers test preparation for a variety of educational and career exams, as well as practice in various educational and career skills. Included are practice exams for GED, SAT, ACT, GRE, ASVAB, PRAXIS and more as well as components to help with educational and career skills.

NoveList Plus

Reading suggestions, both fiction and nonfiction, based on what you've read and enjoyed, favorite authors, or topics of interest.

Online Book Clubs

Join our *Online Book Club* and read a 5-minute book excerpt in your email each day. By the end of the week, you'll have read 2-3 chapters.

Points of View Reference Center

Designed to aid students in understanding the full scope of controversial subjects, *Points of View* will help them prepare for debates, develop arguments, write position papers, and develop critical thinking skills. Each essay includes a series of questions to generate further thought, and additional supporting articles from periodicals, newspapers, and books.

Reference USA

Information on over 10 million businesses across the United States is available and searchable by company name, type of business, location, names of company officers and other criteria.

Science Online

Geared for students in middle through high school, this database contains information on a broad range of scientific disciplines. It is organized by subject area and searchable by keyword or phrase and includes biographies, essays, definitions, diagrams, experiments, a timeline, and web links.
